



Service Department Report April 2016

Parks/Properties Projects:

Town Hall Campus:

- Water testing-routine maintenance
- Started to investigate ceiling issue

River Road Park:

- Opened Park – repairing waterline in restroom
- Worked with KCE on concession stand access- They will be opening for business soon
- Moved goals over for soccer season

Settlers Park:

- Opened park for season- Install speed bumps
- Moved goals, as needed
- Water testing- routine maintenance

Centerville Mills Park:

- Continued work on HVAC/Electrical upgrade
- Started front entrance project
- Started excavating for Pavement project-installed detention basin and structures- seeded areas
- Installed drip trap on gas line- stoves have now been modified to run on Park's natural gas – no need for propane.
- Requested commercial natural gas main connection at Crackel Road as a back-up. Will be manifold for easy cross-over
- Worked with FirstEnergy concerning upgraded service to Dining Hall
- Met with Park's gas representatives concerning connecting Lakeside to system-eliminating electric base board heating
- Achieved consensus on exterior paint colors for Dining Hall-began seeking quotes to perform work
- Design complete for paver installation and put out for bid
- Finalized preliminary design for Blue-room
- Paced order for pavers
- Started stoop and sidewalks-exposed aggregate concrete



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Road Maintenance Facility:

- Graded side building expansion and seeded
- Completed auxiliary lot perpetrations for clean-up days

Other:

- Installed landscaping at St. Rt. 422 & 306 interchange 'Welcome Signs'
- Straightened fences, and continued to install other 'Welcome Signs'
- Performed some plowing damage repair to lawns
- Cold patching in isolated areas- will be out with Durapatcher work after Clean-up Days.
- Several snow and ice events- later switched all equipment over for summer work
