The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in emergency session at the Bainbridge Town Hall. Those present were trustees Mrs. Lorrie Sass Benza and Mr. Jeffrey S. Markley and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Cherianne H. Measures. Trustee Mr. Christopher Horn absent. Mrs. Benza presided and called the meeting to order at 1:20 P.M.

Mrs. Benza explained the purpose of the meeting, which is to discuss the status of a structure located at 16704 Bedford Street in the Chagrin Falls Park neighborhood. The structure has been declared insecure, unsafe, and structurally defective by both the Geauga County Building Department and the Bainbridge Township Fire Department. However, the township has received complaints from neighbors that children from the area have been playing in and around the structure.

Mrs. Benza made a motion to approve emergency measures be taken by the Bainbridge Township Service Department to secure the structure located at the address previously stated, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 505.86(B), effective immediately.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

Since there was no further business to come before this meeting of the Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees, the meeting was adjourned at 1:22 P.M.
