The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Bainbridge Town Hall on April 22, 2019. Those present were Trustees Mrs. Lorrie Benza, Mr. Jeffrey Markley, and Mrs. Kristina O'Brien and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Janice S. Sugarman. Mrs. Benza presided and called the meeting to order at 6:02 P.M.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mrs. Benza made a motion to go into executive session for the Employment and Compensation of Public Employees per Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1).

Mrs. O'Brien seconded the motion. Vote followed: Mrs. Benza, aye; Mrs. O'Brien, aye; Mr. Markley, aye. Motion carried.

The trustees recessed their regular meeting at 6:02 P.M. in order to go into executive session.

The trustees returned from executive session, after considering the employment and compensation of public employees and reconvened their regular meeting at 7:02 P.M.

MINUTES

Mrs. O'Brien moved to approve the minutes of the trustees' April 8, 2019 regular meeting as written.

PRESENTATION BY GUEST – Mr. Dave Conley and Ms. Wendy Zele, First Energy

Mr. Conley presented information on First Energy's procedures for Storm Restoration, Forestry, and Circuit Improvements. He explained that First Energy handles safety issues first, then takes care of repairs. Their website is www.firstenergycorp.com and all of the information presented can be found there. Mr. Bill Clark of 8681 Tanglewood Trail asked about the trees on the power lines on State Route 306. Ms. Zele advised that they be reported through First Energy's emergency number.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Jon Bokovitz gave the police department report for the month of March 2019. The golf outing is May 24, 2019 and benefits Shop-with-a-Cop and Safety Town. Safety Town registration is going through KCE this year. Over 130 students are registered. Chief Bokovitz also reported two unique incidents this month. The first incident was a stolen car that was recovered with the thief still driving it. The other incident involved officers who revived an overdose victim with Narcan. FIRE DEPARTMENT

Chief Lou Ann Metz presented the fire department report for the month of March 2019. Citizen's Fire Academy begins on April 24, 2019. They have 24 residents registered. She reported that the Easter Egg Hunt was a huge success with 300 people in attendance. She thanked the community sponsors for their support. The chief reminded residents that open burning is not permitted. Residents need to go to the Lake County Health Department for a permit. The complete fire report is attached to and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

ZONING DEPARTMENT

Mrs. Karen Endres presented the zoning department report for the month of March 2019. The zoning department took in \$2,900.00 in receipts and had four new home permits in March. Since Ruby Tuesday closed, there is an out-of-state company looking at putting a retail strip center there. In addition, Judson is looking to develop another phase. Mr. Marty Sfiligoj of South Spring Valley asked where he could go to get help determining his property lines. Mrs. Endres suggested that her department could help as well at the Real Link portion of the Geauga County Auditor's site. The complete zoning report is attached to and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Bill Clark of 8681 Tanglewood Trail shared his concerns regarding the recycling situation and the trees on power lines on State Route 306. The trustees explained the relationship between Bainbridge Township and the Geauga Trumbull Solid Waste Management District.

FIRE DEPARTMENT – NEW BUSINESSTraining Request - Bolt

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to approve the training request for Firefighter Chuck Bolt to attend the EMS Charts User Conference in Charlotte, NC from May 14-16, 2019 at an estimated cost of \$1934.40 with the use of a township vehicle per the recommendation of the fire chief and as specified in the training request.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

Request to Declare Obsolete

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to declare two network switches obsolete and no longer needed by the township pursuant to ORC 505.10, per the recommendation of the fire chief.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that was passed unanimously.

Disposal of Obsolete Items

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to dispose of the obsolete switches by recycling them after county approval, per the recommendation of the fire chief and in accordance with ORC 505.10.

Training Request – Metz

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to approve the training request for Chief LouAnn Metz to attend the Academy I: The Foundation of Labor Relations training in Columbus, OH from June 19-20, 2019 at an estimated cost of \$655.70 with the use of a township vehicle per the recommendation of the fire chief and as specified in the training request.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

POLICE DEPARTMENT – NEW BUSINESSDonation Acknowledgement

The trustees were in general agreement to accept the donation of a metal cage with installation valued at \$2,700.00 for use at the SWAT Building on Bainbridge Road in accordance with ORC 505.10, and with extreme gratitude for the donation.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT – OLD BUSINESSParks Questionnaire

Mrs. O'Brien and Mr. Marty Sfiligoj of the Parks Committee discussed the purpose of a parks questionnaire for residents. After much discussion, it was generally agreed that the Parks Committee would hold off on this type of questionnaire for the time being. But it was also decided that Mr. Markley would revise the questionnaire, paring it down so that the dissemination of the questions and use of the information received can be submitted for appropriate grant opportunities. Mr. Markley will share revisions with the other trustees at a future meeting. The trustees hope to use Survey Monkey as a method for sharing the questionnaire and gaining opinions. KCE has worked recently with Auburn Township on a similar questionnaire, so Mr. Markley will contact their representatives to determine the input rate from their efforts.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT – NEW BUSINESSCemetery – Form to Sell Back Graves

The trustees were in general agreement to adopt a form for selling back graves to the township per the recommendation of the service director and the cemetery board.

Approval of Plans/Authorization to Bid – RC-BAI-V-2019

Mrs. O'Brien moved to approve Resolution 04222019 - A , adopting the specifications and estimates, and ordering the Reconstruction of Various Roads including TR-0860-A Hawksmoor Way, TR-0861-A Bramshill Circle, and TR-1002-A Granite Ridge per ORC 5573.01 as recommended by the Geauga County Engineer and the service director, and further authorizing the fiscal officer to advertise the project for competitive bidding with bids to be received by 10:00AM on May 10, 2019 and opened at 10:10AM on the same day.
