The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Bainbridge Town Hall on July 22, 2019. Those present were Trustees Mr. Jeffrey Markley, Mrs. Kristina O'Brien and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Janice Sugarman. Mrs. Lorrie Benza was absent. Mrs. O'Brien presided and called the meeting to order at 6:13 P.M.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to go into executive session for Employment and Compensation of Public Employees per Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1) and Collective Bargaining per Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(4).

Mr. Markley seconded the motion. Vote followed: Mr. Markley, aye; Mrs. O'Brien, aye. Motion carried.

The trustees recessed their regular meeting at 6:13 P.M. in order to go into executive session.

Chief Bokovitz was invited into the executive session at 6:31 P.M. and left at 7:02 P.M.

The trustees returned from executive session, after discussing employment and compensation of public employees and collective bargaining, and reconvened their meeting at 7:08 P.M.

MINUTES

Mrs. O'Brien moved to approve the minutes of the trustees' July 8, 2019 regular meeting as submitted.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Markley, aye; Mrs. O'Brien, aye. Motion carried.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

ZONING DEPARTMENT REPORT

Ms. Karen Endres, Zoning Inspector presented the zoning department report for the month of June 2019. She stated that the Zoning Department received \$3,800.00 in fees for the month of June, and she issued permits for two new homes. She is continuing to work with the Morgan Company relevant to the Ruby Tuesday property and noted that the Montessori School is up for auction and she has had inquiries on how that property may be used. The complete zoning department report is attached and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

Chief Metz presented the fire department report for the month of June 2019. She reported that the month of June was busier than the month of May, but not as busy as the month of July has been so far. In June they had 58 residents and 32 non-residents, they transported 70 people. The Weils was their busiest facility this month, they accounted for 11% and they are about 14.5% overall and between the Weils, Prompt Care and South Franklin Circle. That is 23.35% of the calls in those concentrated areas. The average time it takes the EMS and Firefighters from the minute that the tones start to go off until they are through the door and on the road was 65.42 seconds and the national standard is 90 seconds, so we are 24.5 seconds under the national standard. The overall response time is 3 minutes, 22 seconds, so that is 38 seconds below national standard. We are being very responsive as 9 full seconds were shaved off of their average time from this time last year. The fire department has received some significant donations that will be used to replace the safety trailer. The complete fire department report is attached and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

Grade Change Request

Liquor Permits

The trustees acknowledged receipt of a letter from the Department of Commerce regarding all liquor permits in the township that will expire on October 1, 2019. Based on the recommendation of the police chief, the trustees were in general agreement and had no objection to the current list of permit holders in the township.

<u>Liquor License Transfer and Hearing – JD Restaurant Services, Inc. (Zeppe's)</u>

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to authorize the chief police officer to complete the appropriate paperwork involved in the permit application to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control for a transfer of liquor license from A & A Restaurant Services, Inc. to JD Restaurant Services, Inc. and a hearing will not be requested by the trustees, based on the recommendation of the police chief.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT - OLD BUSINESS

OPWC Project Grant Agreement - Rescission

Mrs. O'Brien moved to rescind the action taken at the BOT July 8, 2019 meeting approving and allowing the trustees to execute the pertinent OPWC Agreement, and to further allow the Fiscal Officer to complete any necessary paperwork as well as other required steps to facilitate the disbursement of approved funds to Bainbridge Township per the recommendation of the Service Director.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

OPWC Project Grant Agreement

Mrs. O'Brien moved to approve and allow Trustee Jeff Markley to execute the pertinent OPWC Agreement, and to further allow the Fiscal Officer to complete any necessary paperwork as well as other required steps to facilitate the disbursement of approved funds to Bainbridge Township per the recommendation of the Service Director.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

PUBLIC INTERACTION

Mr. Peter Cary, property manager; Mr. Peter McCoy of 7207 Chagrin Partners and Attorney Jaredd Flynn of Thrasher, Dinsmore & Dolan were present to represent Zoning Amendment Z-2019-1. They explained the re-zoning request that will re-zone the properties from Professional Office District to Light Industry Restricted.

ZONING - NEW BUSINESS

Public Hearing – Zoning Amendment Z-2019-1

The trustees recessed their regular meeting at 8:00 P.M. in order to go into the public hearing. Mrs. O'Brien called the public hearing to order at 8:00 P.M. to discuss Zoning Amendment Z-2019-1. She then proceeded to summarize the content of the amendment and explain the need for it. The zoning amendment is to rezone parcels at 7207 Chagrin Road and 7209 Chagrin Road from Professional Office District (P-O) to Light Industry Restricted District (LIR) and to further amend the text of the Bainbridge Township Zoning Resolution Section 155.02 (a) as proposed. The public hearing was advertised in the News Herald on July 12, 2019.

Mrs. O'Brien called for comments in support of the zoning amendment. There were three people in support of the zoning amendment: Mr. Jaredd Flynn of Thrasher, Dinsmore & Dolan, Mr. Peter McCoy of 7207 Chagrin Road Partners and Mr. Peter Cary, property manager. It was explained that the property has always been used as Light Industrial and the rezoning to Professional Office was a mistake in the zoning originally in 1991. One of the buildings doesn't have windows and they have loading docks. Nothing is changing, the properties have been used as light industrial so it is not a new project, it is to clean up a mistake.

- Mr. Markley asked what precipitated the change.
- Mr. Cary explained that a Soupbase Company wanted to lease one of the spaces but they found out that the use was not permitted in a Professional Office District.
- Ms. Endres stated that she was contacted by the Geauga County Health Department.
 - Mr. Cary said that was the trigger.
- Mr. Markley asked Ms. Endres about the triangular piece that is 7227 Chagrin Road which is front of this, it looks like a portion of the property line goes right through the parking lot so a portion of that parking is going to end up being LIR and then the other portion will be residential so he is curious how that is set up, right now it is POD and it has zoning district lines that are splitting the parking lot too. Does that create any challenges and was that even discussed at the zoning commission level.
- Ms. Endres replied that when the building was constructed originally it was LIR and at some point it was rezoned from LIR to Professional Office and she thinks that was the beginning of the Professional Office zoning district. She said she was trying to get the permitting in order so the tenants in each unit would apply for zoning and noted that not all of the businesses in there are permitted as professional office.
- Mr. Markley asked if there were any comments from the zoning commission or BZA that were a concern or anything we should be aware of.
- Ms. Endres said she doesn't think there are any concerns, a use variance was in front of the BZA but it was tabled until the re-zoning is completed.
 - Mr. Markley asked with regard to rezoning it, did they support it.
 - Ms. Endres said yes.
 - Mr. Markley asked about the Geauga County Planning Commission comments.
- Ms. Endres said the only comments they had was relevant to similar uses in the text portion.
 - Mrs. O'Brien called for comments against the zoning amendment. There were none.

The trustees discussed the changes and options being suggested for the zoning amendment.

- Mrs. O'Brien closed the public hearing at 8:10 P.M.
- Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to approve Zoning Amendment Z-2019-1 with the Zoning Commission recommendations contained in the letter dated June 11, 2019.
 - Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.


