The regular meeting of the Bainbridge Township Zoning Commission was called to order by Mr. David Weiss, Chairman, at 7:30 P.M. Members present were: Ms. Denise Januska, Ms. Lorrie Sass, Mr. Donald Sheehy and Mr. Stephen Yingling.

MINUTES

Zoning Inspector

StabiliGrid

The zoning commission members discussed the product Stabiligrid that is used for parking areas and driveways and were in agreement that it is considered lot coverage.

PUBLIC HEARING

Proposed Zoning Amendment Z-2007-1

Mr. Weiss called the public hearing to order at 7:45 P.M. Members present were Ms. Denise Januska, Ms. Lorrie Sass, Mr. Donald Sheehy and Mr. Stephen Yingling.

Proposed amendment Z-2007-1 is a motion by the zoning commission to amend the definition of structure as follows:

"Structure" means anything constructed or erected, the use of which requires a fixed location on the ground or is attached to something having a fixed location on the ground, and includes, but is not limited to, buildings, parking areas, driveways, fences, seating facilities, platforms, backstops, pergolas, ponds, pools, poles, tanks, tents, towers, transformer substations, signs, walls, canopies, air supported structures, street gutters, detention basins, extended detention basins, retention basins, constructed wetlands, infiltration basins, catch basins, oil/water separators, sediment basins, modular, porous and solid pavements, and aggregate stone driveways, parking lots and sidewalks. *Structure also includes any edifice used for storage*.

Mr. Weiss explained the proposed amendment regarding the definition of structure and that the existing definition requires a structure to be fixed to the ground and by removing the word "fixed" it eliminates someone using the back of a tractor trailer for storage. He also noted that the zoning commission added "Structure also includes any edifice used for storage." to the proposed amendment.

Ms. Sass said it will also regulate temporary structures such as pods.

Mr. Weiss solicited comments for the amendment: None.

Mr. Weiss solicited comments against the amendment: None.

Mr. Weiss closed the public hearing at 7:52 P.M.

The regular meeting was reconvened at 7:52 P.M.

Mr. Weiss made a motion to recommend approval of Z-2007-1.

Ms. Sass seconded the motion that passed unanimously.
