Zoning Resolution Update

Mr. Wrench will notify the aforementioned stakeholders/focus groups regarding the interviews to be held June 4, 2012 and June 5, 2012. Kendig Keast Collaborative will also hold a Citizens' Congress for all township residents the evening of June 5, 2012 with the location to be determined.
