Kendig Keast Collaborative (Comprehensive Zoning Resolution Re-Write)

The members questioned the difference between NC-5 versus NC-5L and NC-3 versus NC-3L and were in agreement to continue to research the proposed zoning map outside of the meeting and to create a list of known problems that were discussed.
