Promotion

Mr. Horn made a motion to promote Patrolman Brian Frew from a Grade B Patrolman to a Grade A Patrolman, effective March 3, 2007 at an annual rate of \$55,209.10 per the recommendation of Police Chief James Jimison.

Vehicle Purchase

TOWNSHIP AUDIT COMMITTEE

The trustees interviewed Sandy Cloninger for a position on the Audit Committee. The State Auditors suggested the township establish an audit committee to serve as a liaison between management and its auditors. The primary functions of such a committee are to monitor and review the Township's accounting and financial reporting practices, and to follow up on recommendations made by its auditors.

PROPOSED WATER MAIN EASEMENT

The trustees met with Jim Pezar from Hess & Associates Engineering Inc. for a discussion on a water main easement between Flintlock Ridge on the north, and Canyon Lakes Colony Phase 12, also known as Canyon Woods, on the south. This water line is required by the Geauga County Department of Water Resources, and it is needed to continue developing the 90 acre parcel located on Bainbridge Road adjacent to the Bainbridge Township property east of River Road.

KENSTON LAKES DAM

Trustees White and Markley met with Asst. County Prosecutor Chris Sheridan and representatives from Chagrin River Watershed Partners for a discussion on further funding options for the Kenston Lake dam problems.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

Sale of Snow Plow
