

The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in special session at the Bainbridge Town Hall on July 21, 2006 to review the Cleveland State University report on flooding at Cedar/South Streets and to consider any other necessary business. Those present were trustees Mr. Christopher Horn, Mr. Jeffrey S. Markley and Ms. Linda W. White. Fiscal Officer Susan R. Angelino was absent. The meeting was called to order at 3:05 P.M.

NEW BUSINESS

CEDAR/SOUTH STREETS FLOODING

The trustees met with Frank McIntyre, Zoning Inspector, Bob Phillips, Geauga County Engineer, Kyle Dreyfuss-Wells, Chagrin River Watershed Partners, Carmella Shale, Geauga Soil & Water Conservation District, Ben Himes, Chagrin Falls Village and residents for a discussion and review of the Cleveland State University report on the flooding conditions at Cedar/South Streets.

The trustees said they did not have a solution but would consider several options. Among those are:

1. Petition ditch process.
2. Storm water utility program.
