The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Bainbridge Town Hall on July 27, 2009. Those present were trustees Mr. Matthew J.D. Lynch, Mr. Jeffrey S. Markley and Ms. Linda W. White and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Cherianne H. Measures. Mr. Lynch presided and called the meeting to order at 6:45 P.M.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Lynch made a motion to go into executive session to discuss the appointment of a public official.

Ms. White seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

The trustees recessed their regular meeting at 6:46 P.M. in order to go into executive session to discuss the appointment of a public official.

The trustees returned from executive session after discussing the appointment of a public official reconvening their meeting at 7:00 P.M.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

Mr. Walter Rudyk, Road Superintendent, presented the monthly report for the month of June 2009.

Ms. White asked Mr. Rudyk what the status was of the stop signs on Haskins Road and Lake In The Woods Trail. Mr. Rudyk stated that he has not heard from the County Engineer's office regarding this matter.

FULL TIME SKILLED MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEE

Mr. Lynch questioned the need to replace the full time Road Department employee that is no longer working for the Township due to a disability. Mr. Rudyk stated that the department does need to replace this employee in order to maintain the level of service.

Mr. Lynch asked Mr. Rudyk to contact comparable communities to research the extent of road crews to research the need for full time employees versus part time employees for the Road Department.

A.T. Finn, of Carnes Road, is concerned about the visibility when attempting to go South on Chillicothe Road from Taylor May Road due to a dirt pile and grasses. Mr. Rudyk was asked to look into this issue.

Hawksmoor Way Project

Mr. Lynch moved to award the bid for the Hawksmoor Way to the lowest and best bid for this project to Phil Miller Construction, Inc. of Middlefield in the amount of \$140,445.00 per the recommendation of the Road Superintendent and the Geauga County Engineer's Office.

Ms. White seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

TRUSTEES CORNER

Kenston Community Education

Ms. White reviewed the profit and loss statement from Kenston Community Education through June of 2009 for a balance of -\$11,328. This information was presented to the residents since this information has a bearing on the decisions made regarding the old Bainbridge School.

Ms. Gina Zahn shared the information she was given by KCE. She contacted Mr. Doak, president of KCE, to inquire about the discrepancies, but she has not heard back from KCE.

Mr. Markley asked if the Kenston Community Education Board was notified of this information being presented this evening. The answer was no. Mr. Markley stated that he appreciated Ms. Zahn's efforts and presentation. Ms. White stated that she has asked for minutes and information from KCE and the information has not been provided. The purpose of this discussion is to inform that the information being provided by KCE is not consistent.

Kenston Lake Dam EPA Grant

Mr. Lynch authorized Mr. Markley to executed the quarterly Ohio EPA expense report for the Kenston Lake Dam project.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

Bethel Back To School Carnival

Mr. Lynch asked if the board felt the trustees should contribute to this worthwhile cause. After much discussion, the board made the decision to postpone this topic to the agenda for next week.

Levy Resolution

Mr. Lynch moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Bainbridge Township, Geauga County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Bainbridge Township for the purpose of the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the township, pursuant to ORC 5705.19(G) at a rate not exceeding 1.00 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of (5) years and which is a renewal of an existing 1.00 mill Road and Bridge Levy.

RESOLVED, That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Bainbridge Township at the General election to be held at the usual voting places within said Township on the 3rd day of November, 2009; and be it further

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year if majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Fiscal Officer of this Board of Trustees be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio, as passed on July 27, 2009 and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

Mr. Markley seconded the Motion and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of Bainbridge Township, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said township, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

That there be appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$300,000 to the line item entitled Capital Outlay - Other (1000-760-790-0000); and,

That there be appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$400,000 to the line item entitled Highway Other (1000-330-599-0000); and

That the Township Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from the foregoing appropriations upon approval by the Board of Trustees, who are authorized by law to approve same.

This resolution shall be deemed an emergency measure, effective upon passage.
