### CHAGRIN VALLEY ENGINEERING INVOICE

Trustee Markley read a statement about his relationship with Chagrin Valley Engineering, with whom the township entered into contracts for engineering services in 2007 for River Road Park and Restland Cemetery. The written statement is entered into the minutes and included in the public record.

Trustee Lynch commended Mr. Markley on being an extremely hard working and valuable member of the Board. He stated that he was reluctant to raise any issue that could be construed as a potential conflict of interest but that he had an unresolved question as to Mr. Markley's connection to Chagrin Valley Engineering through his involvement with Ohio Stream Preservation, a non-profit organization dedicated to conservation of streams and wetlands.

During the ensuing discussion, resident Mitch Fakadej said that the primary question was whether Mr. Markley was being compensated by OSP money-wise in any way. Mr. Markley stated that two of the five OSP Board members are employees of Chagrin Valley Engineering as is the OSP secretary-treasurer and that the five-member board approves his invoices and he is compensated for the time he puts in.
