NEW BUSINESS

CEDAR/SOUTH STREET FLOODING ISSUES

The trustees discussed background study done by Cleveland State students as to issues and recommended solutions to flooding problems.

Ms. Dreyfuss-Wells and Ms. Shale discussed the Ohio Emergency Management Agencies Hazard Mitigation Grant Program which makes money available to communities declared Federal Disaster areas. Geauga County qualifies because of the July, 2006 flooding that occurred. Property owners must have had structural damage attributed to flooding.

Residents in attendance were asked to chronicle their flooding events over the past years.

The trustees were in general agreement to go forward with the pre-application process for this grant.
