The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Bainbridge Town Hall on December 18, 2024. Those present were Trustees Mr. Jeff Markley and Mrs. Kristina O'Brien and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Janice Sugarman. Dr. Michael Bates was absent. Mrs. O'Brien presided and called the meeting to order at 6:31P.M.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mrs. O'Brien made a motion to recess the regular meeting and go into executive session for the Employment and Compensation of Public Employees per Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1).

Mr. Markley seconded the motion. Roll call vote followed: Mr. Markley, aye; Mrs. O'Brien, aye. Motion carried.

The trustees recessed their meeting at 6:31 P.M. to go into executive session.

The trustees returned from executive session and reconvened their regular meeting at 7:02 P.M. and everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES APPROVAL

Mrs. O'Brien moved to approve the minutes of the trustees' December 9, 2024 regular meeting and December 16, 2024 special meeting as written.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

FIRE DEPARTMENT

There was no verbal fire department report for the month of November 2024. The complete fire report is attached to and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

There was no verbal police department report for the month of November 2024. The complete police report is attached to and becomes a permanent part of these minutes.

ZONING DEPARTMENT

Mr. Steve Averill presented the zoning department report for the month of November 2024. The zoning department took in \$49,825.00 in receipts (\$47,000.00 from Vision Development) in November with four new housing starts and 17 total permits issued for the month. SERVICE DEPARTMENT – NEW BUSINESS

Cemetery Sexton

Mrs. O’Brien made a motion to approve the amended job description for cemetery sexton per the recommendation of the service director.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that was passed unanimously.

Mrs. O’Brien made a motion to appoint Christina Piotrowski to the position of Cemetery Sexton with a monthly stipend of \$500.00 effective January 2025 per the recommendation of the service director.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that was passed unanimously.

TRUSTEES – NEW BUSINESS

Wage Increases for Non-bargaining Employees

Mrs. O’Brien made a motion to approve the wage adjustments for the non-bargaining employees in the township consistent with discussions in executive session. These increases will be effective starting the first full pay period in January 2025.

Mr. Markley seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

JEDD Updates

Mrs. O’Brien updated the board on the Aurora JEDD. The meeting last month was to establish the board, which currently consists of Mrs. O’Brien and the Aurora mayor. There will be three additional members added. The next meeting is January 15, 2025. There are no updates for the Solon JEDD.

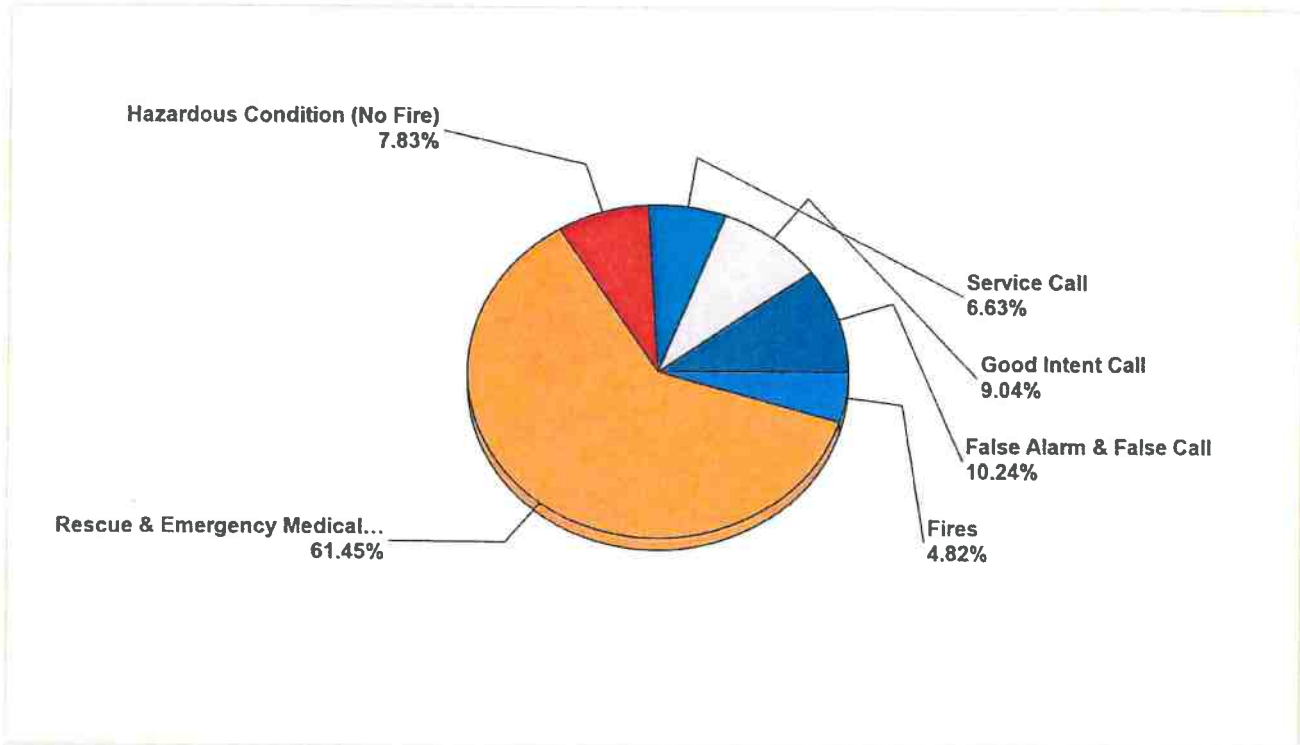
