The Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees met in a special meeting at the Bainbridge Town Hall on November 6, 2025. Those present were Trustees Dr. Michael Bates and Mr. Jeff Markley. Mr. Markley presided and called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Also present were Solon Mayor Edward Kraus and Sarah Kostura, Associate Law Director for the City of Solon.

A discussion followed regarding the Rails to Trails project, to convert former Norfolk-Southern railroad tracks into a trail connecting Solon through Bainbridge and into Aurora.

Mr. Markley made a motion to approve Resolution 11172025-A, which is a resolution for approving, solely for the purpose of Section 147(F) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, the issuance of various purpose bond anticipation notes by the City of Solon, Ohio and authorizing other documents in connections with the issuance of the notes.

Dr. Bates seconded the motion that was passed unanimously.

Mr. Markley made a motion to approve an MOU between Bainbridge Township and the City of Solon establishing the city as the owner of the property and responsible for acquiring the land, giving Bainbridge Township the right to proceed with line-of-sight improvements in several areas where the Solon property crosses Geauga Lake Road and Brewster Road. Dr. Bates seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Dr. Bates seconded the motion that was passed unanimously.

Since there was no further business to come before this special meeting of the Bainbridge Township Board of Trustees, Mr. Markley made a motion to adjourn with a second by Dr. Bates and the meeting was adjourned at 4:23 P.M.
